Welcome to the Annual Report of the Fraternity's 150th year.

It is appropriate to issue this special, comprehensive annual report on the momentous occasion of Alpha Sigma Phi's Sesquicentennial Celebration.

I am often asked about today's fraternity trends and about how Alpha Sigma Phi compares.

For 150 years, this great Fraternity of ours has weathered many storms including the Civil War, two World Wars, and the student revolution of the '60s and '70s. And today, we are proud to report that Alpha Sigma Phi completed the 1994-95 year in outstanding fashion.

Our chapter-oriented programming increased; our leadership training continued its quiet revolution in the fraternity world; and our membership grew — despite a general five percent decline among all general men's fraternities. Our pledge reporting increased 25% over the previous year, resulting in 177 more men joining Alpha Sigma Phi than during '93-'94.

Our growth trend may be attributed to a number of factors. It could be the improved Presidents Academy of

Leadership. Or our Chapter Leadership Consultant visits. Or maybe it is attributed to our focus in recruiting active Chapter Advisors and other volunteers. Or maybe the increased fraternity programming and education we provide our undergraduates.

Or maybe it is simply the strength of our Brotherhood positioning Alpha Sigma Phi for the next 150 years.

Regardless, Alpha Sigma Phi has strengthened its position in number of men, number of chapters, alumni volunteerism, alumni contributions and so much more. Accomplishments that could not be achieved without your constant support.

Please take a few moments to read this report and take pride in our accomplishments. Then I hope you'll join me in renewing your commitment to Alpha Sigma Phi, as together, we *Reach the Pinnacle*.

Sesquicentennial Annual Report

Renewed dedication. Renewed commitment. Renewed support. Our year in review saw many accomplishments during a time of continued uncertainty on America's college campuses.

While Greek participation dropped some five percent nationwide, Alpha Sigma Phi bucked the trend and increased new undergraduate memberships by 25% over the previous year.

But our success was not unplanned — nor unexpected. It is the result of a renewed spirit of volunteerism and alumni involvement; increased financial resources; and careful programming by your Grand Council and Fraternity Staff.

The following highlights the achievements of the year past — and portends the future of a strong, viable Fraternity heading into the next century.

Developing Leaders


To encourage innovative leadership, innovative training and development is required.

Alpha Sigma Phi's leadership programs are constantly being refined and improved. One program, the Presidents Academy of Leadership, provides intensive leadership training to our chapter leaders, in a neutral setting.

The Second Annual Presidents Academy of Leadership was held in Charlotte, N.C., during January, 1995. The Educational Foundation provided a grant of \$23,000 so that every chapter president could attend at no cost to him or his chapter. Alpha Sigma Phi is one of only five fraternities nationwide to offer such a training program.

This cutting edge program is designed to give attendees an opportunity to develop a deeper awareness of themselves and their actions. They are

given the opportunity to outline a vision for their goals and taught how to develop a leader's action plan.

The tremendous success of this program has precipitated a change in name and format. In 1996 the program becomes the Academy of Leadership with Foundation funding covering costs for a Chapter's President and Pledge Educators to attend.

For Gentlemen And Scholars

Each year Alpha Sigma Phi awards academic scholarships based on excellence and grants based upon economic need. Additionally, the Foundation funds leadership scholarships to assist young men by exposing them to leadership training outside of Alpha Sigma Phi.

This past year saw the Foundation providing almost \$22,000 in scholarships and grants to our student Brothers.

During the 1994 Convention, many concerned Brothers took time to go 'Into the Streets,' a program in which undergrads spent the day playing and working with disadvantaged or disabled Chicago children.

Service To Undergraduate Chapters

Alpha Sigma Phi experienced extraordinary growth during 1994-95. The Fraternity grew from 53 chapters, colonies and interest groups to 56. This matches our largest number of active chapters and colonies in five years. Average chapter size also grew from 39 men per chapter to 43 men per chapter, a positive indicator of the growing strength of our chapters.

The Fraternity elected to continue its policy of providing proactive leadership for our undergraduate chapters through personal visits by our professional staff. Our two Chapter Leadership Consultants travelled to 51 chapters at least once during the year. The consultants' goals for each visit included providing a model for success in the specific areas of chapter operation (i.e., scholarship, brotherhood development, charitable giving) in which the chapter has targeted to excel. An Educational Grant of \$90,000 from the Foundation supported travel and salaries for the Chapter Leadership Consultants and their support services.

The Fraternity continued to emphasize the importance of delivering programs that have positive, direct impact on our undergraduate brothers. In 1994 a Task Force on the Future of Chapter Services was formed to specifically address the major issues of impacting our undergraduates and fulfilling our mission, To Create and Perpetuate Brotherhood.

The Task Force addressed several issues to help shape Fraternity programming. Four key elements of a successful undergraduate experience were identified including:

- A safe environment
- Communication
- Commitment
- Integrity

These four elements provide the foundation for building a relationship with self, other brothers and the community at large.

The Task Force also examined the philosophy of Alpha Sigma Phi and outlined four important factors that need to be included in all undergraduate programming. These are:

- Brotherhood development is the highest priority of the Fraternity
- Positive impact during pledging and the first year of membership is central to our success
- The process in which members experience Brotherhood is more critical than the content produced by that experience
- Chapter operations training should become centralized.

A two-part program was recommended to ensure meeting the goal of a positive undergraduate experience. The program consists of:

- Three high quality, high impact national programs to address personal and chapter needs regardless of chapter affiliation and to provide the collective experience of a national brotherhood:
 - New Members Program
 - National Leadership Conference
 - Academy of Leadership
- Brotherhood building programs to ensure the Brotherhood experience is real, compelling and provides focus for goal setting, evaluation and maintaining brotherhood, including:
 - Brotherhood building experiences
 - Brotherhood maintenance & evaluation

A chapter-based program in a retreat format is being developed for use at every chapter. The weekend long program is run by a professional facilitator and focuses on each chapter in developing true brotherhood. The program will remain in its pilot stages until Fall, 1996.

The celebration kick-off was held in Columbus and Delaware, Ohio. Alumni and guests attended an opening reception on Friday evening, December 9, 1994 where many brothers met for the first time and old friendships were renewed.

On a chilly afternoon on Saturday, December 10, brothers, spouses and guests met to dedicate a monument and garden area at Ohio Wesleyan University to the memory of Brother Ralph F. Burns, Ohio Wesleyan '32, Omega '93. The monument was completely paid for by special gifts from Brothers and friends and is a fitting tribute to one who dedicated his life to the brotherhood.

The Educational Foundation took advantage of the Sesquicentennial Celebration Kickoff and launched a \$3 million campaign to enhance current programs and fund new programs that have been researched and developed during the past three years. Kevin J. Garvey, Westminster '75, Grand Treasurer, announced the campaign began with more than \$500,000 committed.


During 1994-1995, five colonies were established; and one chartered, Delta Tau at Murray State University.

Celebrating 150 Years Of Brotherhood



1994-95 Fraternity Revenue




1994-95 Fraternity Expenses


1994-95 Educational Foundation Revenue

In December, 1995, the campaign reached its one year goal of \$1,500,000.

The Celebration continued in the home city of our principal founder, Louis Manigault in Charleston, S.C., August 9-13, with the Fraternity's National Leadership Conference. Unique programs included visits to historic Manigault sites in the Charleston area, with a special marker placed and dedicated to Louis Manigault at his final resting place in the Magnolia Cemetery.

The Educational Foundation provided a grant of \$55,000 to the celebration, keeping the costs for undergraduates at \$300 per man. Scholarships to attend were also provided by the Foundation covering registration fees for 25 students. Named scholarships were given for each Brother donating \$1,000 or more annually. The foundation was able to provide 25 scholarships for a total of \$7,500 in registration fees.

Providing A Strong Base From The Educational Foundation

Alpha Sigma Phi was beneficiary of more financial contributions during 1994-1995 than in any of the previous five years. More than 2,000 contributors donated a total of \$170,602; including, \$113,342 for the Annual Loyalty Fund, \$13,400 for the Ralph Burns Fund, \$8,668 for Restricted Funds, and \$35,129 for Endowment.

The endowment grew from \$6.9 million on June 30, 1994 to \$7.4 million on June 30, 1995. The total return was 13.92%.

The Annual Loyalty Fund and alumni programs are under the direction of G. Scott Grissom, Oklahoma '78, who joined the Foundation's staff in November, 1994. Brother Grissom has exciting plans and goals in working with our 35,000 plus alumni to support Alpha Sigma Phi.

Today, the Educational Foundation enjoys having the fourth largest endowment of any national fraternity foundation. A special investment committee has been formed to manage the endowment to maximize it while maintain a comfortable level of risk.

The investment committee's members include:

A comprehensive investment policy and reporting system has been established by the investment committee and the Educational Foundation Trustees. This system is designed to better monitor the Foundation's investments and ensure that its resources are properly utilized.

The Foundation's endowment continues to grow through contributions and bequests that generous Brothers and friends leave to perpetuate Alpha Sigma Phi's excellence.

The Educational Foundation received additional monies from the estate of Howard L. Kleinoeder, Washington '35. A final disbursement of his original gift was made after a horse farm left in his estate was sold.

The Educational Foundation also named two new members to its board of trustees during this past year. New Trustees are:

- Ronald W. Dollens, Purdue '65 — Zionsville, IN, is President and Chief Executive Officer of Guidant Corporation
- John T. Kauffman, Purdue '43 — Emmaus, PA, retired Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Pennsylvania Power & Light Company

Another role of the Foundation is to support publication of educational materials. During 1994-1995, \$34,050 was provided for educational publications, manuals and videos — and those portions of *The Tomahawk* that report information on educational topics or the Foundation's activities were underwritten with a \$17,250 Educational Grant.

Daily Support And Operations From The Grand Council and National Headquarters

Alpha Sigma Phi's Grand Council continues to carry-out the mission and goals of the Fraternity between biennial Conventions. Members gather via monthly telephone conferences and with semi-annual weekend meetings to direct the operations of the professional staff.

As a dynamic organization, a variety of staff changes occurred during this past year. Included was the elimination of three administrative positions at the National Headquarters providing some \$65,000 to now be directed to programming for students such as the Brotherhood Building Program for chapters.

This change also reduced personnel expenses from 45% of budget to 35%.

Other staff changes also occurred. These include:

- Glen D. Olson, Bowling Green '92, replacing Jeffery S. Owens, Illinois '87 as Director of Chapter Services. Owens is now a District Executive with the Boy Scouts of America in Cincinnati, OH.
- G. Scott Grissom, Oklahoma '75, replacing Ted Kocher, Findlay '92, as Director of Alumni Services for the Educational Foundation. Kocher became Director of Alumni and Parent Relations at his alma mater.

- S. Alen McKnight, Wake Forest '93, replacing D. Todd Harris, UCLA '92, as Director of Expansion. Harris is now Assistant Director of Public Relations for the California Republican Party.

As in any organization that must bill for its services, Alpha Sigma Phi Fraternity is challenged to keep chapters current with their accounts at Headquarters. In 1993-94, accounts receivable reached a critical level. The implementation of new collections procedures and the introduction of an Alpha Sigma Phi Visa card to be used for pledge and initiation fees became two prime safeguards against further erosion.

We are pleased to report, that one year later, the financial standing of the Fraternity has improved with accounts receivable dropping nearly 50% and greatly strengthening the Fraternity's financial standing.

Better communications between Chapters and Headquarters are also attributed to this remarkable turnaround. Alpha Sigma Phi utilizes a wide variety of media for two-way communications on a variety of topics including the elimination of alcohol abuse and hazing, risk management, scholarships, values and ethics, and scholarship.

To take advantage of electronic mail (E-mail) systems available on most campuses, your National Headquarters is now on the Internet and able to communicate with undergraduates and alumni via computer.

All this is only possible through the generous provisions of time and financial support — and belief in the fundamental principles of our Brotherhood.


In many ways, Alpha Sigma Phi is better poised to head to a next century, than we were heading into this one.

Foundation Grants

The Foundation provides grants to Alpha Sigma Phi Fraternity, Inc. for educational programs which are IRS approved and deemed fitting for the Foundation to fund. Grants for 1994-95 increased \$47,664 over the previous year from \$235,658 in 1993-94 to \$283,322. 
