Should this Charter be granted, we agree to support the Constitution and By - Laws of Alpha Sigma Phi Fraternity, to perform its rituals, and to perform our part in the government and support of the Fraternity as much, and under its Constitution and By - Laws, Rules and Regulations, govern ourselves as a Chapter in harmony and good fellowship, and that we and our successors shall work for the best interests and advancement of the Fraternity wherever and whenever we may, it being understood that nothing in this pledge shall in any way conflict with our religious or political scruples, or our duties and obligations to our family, our college, our country, ourselves, or God.

Kind and History,

The University was founded under the patronage of the Methodist Episcopal Church in 1841 when the original property was acquired and an Academy opened. The Charter was granted in 1843. In 1844 the College of Liberal Arts began its work under the presidency of Dr. Edward Thompson. In 1877, the Ohio Wesleyan Female College, an independent institution that had been established in Delaware in 1853, was incorporated in the University. Its students were admitted to University classes, and its graduates to "ad eundem" degrees and to membership in the Association of Alumni. In 1896, The Cleveland College of Physicians and Surgeons, originally established in 1863, became an integral part of the institution and its subsequent graduates were admitted to the degree of Doctor of Medicine in the University. This school was combined with the Medical Department of Western Reserve University in June, 1910.

Ohio Wesleyan has 14 College buildings; Gray Chapel, the main College building is of gray stone and considered as one of the thirteen most beautiful college buildings in the world, Slocum Library contains more than 65,000 bound volumes besides the periodicals. The growth of the Library averages 2000 volumes a year, Edwards Gymnasium, finished in 1905 at a cost of \$75,000, and

Alpha Epsilon, 1889, Sigma Chi, (date not given);

Chi Phi, founded 1873 became discontinued but was re-established in 1911; ALPHA SIGMA PHI, 1865, discontinued within a few weeks because of dissention in Alpha Chapter.

From these dates it can be seen that there has not been a fraternity established at O.W.U. for 33 years excepting Chi Phi which was re-established by a group of men who formed the local Delta Rio Gamma fraternity after the Union had been organized. During the 46 years from 1869 there were established but two fraternities while during the period previous to that there were seven established.

History.

The Ohio Wesleyan Union was founded December 6, 1909 with sixteen Charter members. The membership was at once increased however and for the last three years the number of the members has been about fifty. The purpose of the Union as stated in the Preamble of the Constitution was as follows;

"The purpose of the organization is to promote the spirit of democracy among the students; to encourage participation in all college activities; educational, social, athletic; to maintain a high standard of scholarship and morality, and to promote Christian fellowship; to secure all the benefits of a close organization and to perpetuate the bond of union between students and their Alma Mater."

Since the founding of the organization, more than three years ago, its members have taken an active part in all lines of college activity, have held many responsible positions in the Student Body, and have had many honors conferred upon them. The alumni now number fifty three. Below is given a brief
