On Thursday each brother in attendance will have the opportunity to begin shaping the future of the Fraternity as the official convention begins. An etiquette luncheon will be held, as well as a presentation by the Fraternity's national philanthropic partner, Canine Companions for Independence. Finally on Thursday, in what is sure to be an unforgettable experience, the Fraternity will hold one of its oldest traditions, a Black Lantern Processional, underneath the historic Gateway Arch.

The business of the Fraternity continues on Friday, along with free-time in the afternoon to explore Union Station, headquarters of *Gateway to the Future*. Union Station was once the hub of all activity in St. Louis, and was recently converted to house shops and many fun gathering spots.

Friday evening, everyone will travel by motor coach to historic St. Charles, MO for dinner and a ritual exemplification aboard the *Goldenrod* showboat, inspiration for the musical *Showboat*. Those not attending the ritual will have the opportunity to experience the largest street fair in the area, the Festival of Little Hills.

There's more free time Saturday afternoon after finishing the Fraternity's business that morning, and then it's time for everyone to look their best at a black-tie-preferred awards banquet in the awe-inspiring Grand Hall of Union Station.

Ways to Save

You may have several opportunities to reduce the cost of your attendance at this summer's National Leadership Conference & Convention *Gateway to the Future*.

First, scholarships for \$125 are available. Applications were sent to your chapter president about a month ago. If you would like one sent to you, contact Headquarters at alphasigs@hcca.ohio.gov

Next, group discounts are available. If five full-paying chapter members attend, you'll only have to pay for four. This does not include members attending on scholarship or the official chapter delegate.

Payment plans are available. Minimum payments of \$25 may be made by cash, check, Mastercard, or Visa until July 1, 1996. The entire registration must be paid in full by July 1.

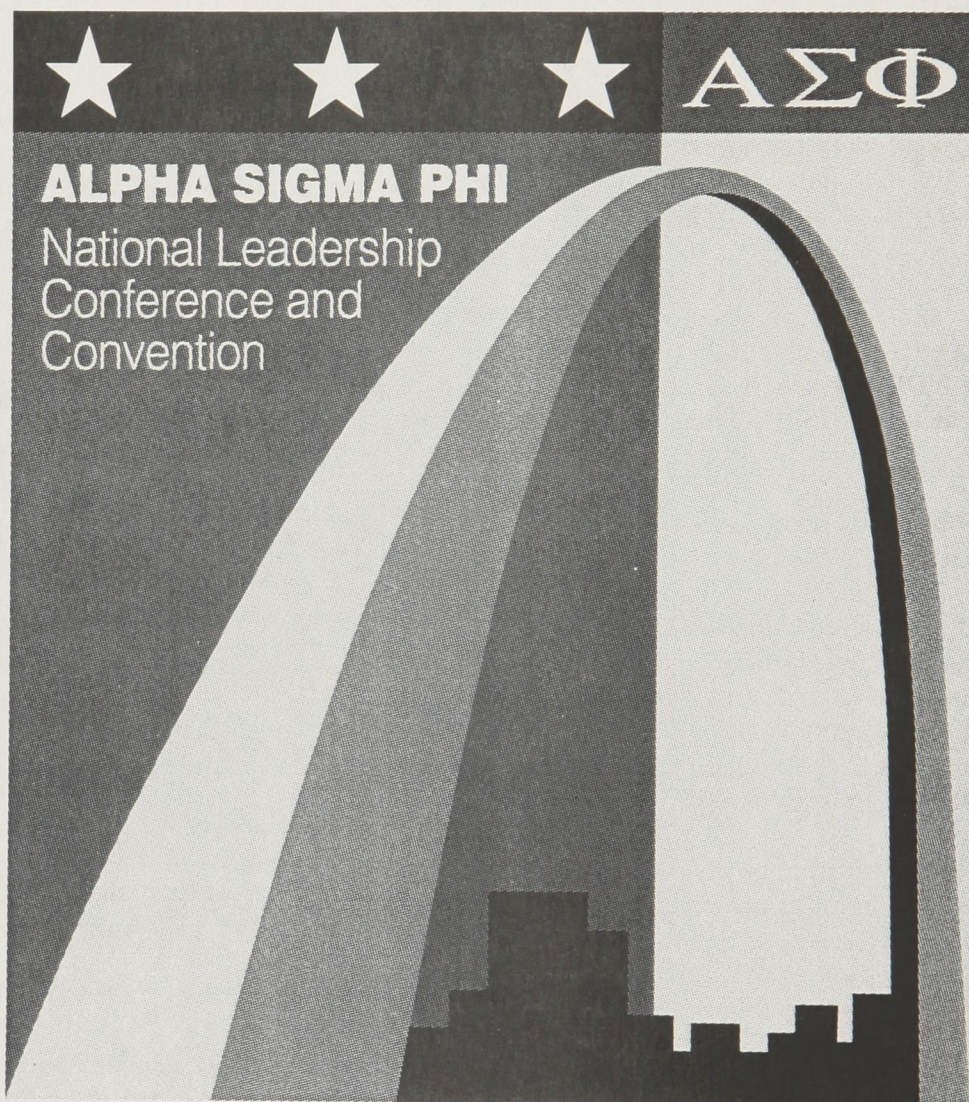
