PETITION.

We, the undersigned, being male students in good standing in the University of Wisconsin, an institution of learning located at Madison, Wisconsin, having hereunto attached our individual and class records do hereby petition Alpha Sigma Phi Fraternity to grant to us and our successors a charter for a Chapter of said Fraternity at this Institution and to assign to us a Chapter Letter in accordance with the Constitution and By-Laws of said Fraternity.

We do each respectively represent that there is no negro blood in our veins, that none of us are of Jewish faith or nationality, that we believe in the sanctity of an oath and will be bound thereby, and that we each of us believe in the principles of good government, high thinking, and decency in living and acting.

Should this charter be granted we agree to support the Constitution and By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, of Alpha Sigma Phi Fraternity, to perform its rituals and observe its traditions and customs, and to perform our part in the government and support of the Fraternity as such, and under its Constitution and By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, govern ourselves as a Chapter in harmony and good fellowship, and that we and our successors shall work for the best interests and advancement of the Fraternity wherever and whenever we may, it being understood that nothing in this pledge nor the obligations we shall be asked to take in the initiatory ceremonies shall

in any way conflict with our religious or political scruples
or our duties and obligations to our college or our country.
